Greetings to all our Brothers and Sisters in Christ from Limon. Many people are already counting down the days until next year, 2021, wishing this year was over. But, one of the lessons I have learned over and over throughout this pandemic is how precious and priceless time is. As believers we should be making the most of every opportunity that we have to bring life and hope to all that we come in contact with.

One of our ministry goals is leadership training.
